Our judge for the live event on 9 August is Margy Short. This will be Margy's second time in Cape Town. Here is a brief outline on Margy

Who do you share your home with?

My husband Tom ...also known as 'Wardrobe" ;). Awesome prop creator. Roxy - Golden Retriever nearly 10, Radley - 1 year old Flat Coat Retriever and Tally, a wee Jackie Russell, - 2 and a bit, a couple of geese and some wild but welcome visitors, the mongoose family, jackal, monkeys and a genet.

Give us a brief rundown of your dancing career?

I saw Yvonne Berger dancing with the legendary Nap at the Rand Show in 2004. I was captivated, not only by this wonderful dancing couple but a whole new 'sport'. Knowing no other than Sit, Stand, Down this 'boogie with your dog' looked utterly amazing ... fun! My BC Tux was my first partner and he retired SA Champ runner up in 2009. Since then I have travelled a beautiful journey with Roxy and am immensely proud of her WCFO Advanced MF Champion and SA Champ 2015 titles.

What would be your ultimate dance tune?

It was Edvard Grieg's, Morning Mood from the Peer Gynt Suites. And I did it! I had been determined to choreograph a dance to this piece for years but I needed many varied behaviours to compliment the changes in pace, the different moods and themes within the melody. I scoured the music sites for weeks to find a version that worked for us. I love Colbie Caillat and have found a couple of pieces that I can listen to a hundred times! And"Little White Duck" by Danny Kaye. Now that's Tally music.



What have been your biggest challenges and how did you overcome them?

Roxy J! Seriously, it took me years to figure how to harness her drive. And when I did ... oh wow! Working through distractions. I consistently worked Roxy in a variety of distracting environments using the highest value treats and toys. In time the distractions became the cue to 'work', though Roxy considers that to mean 'be with my human and have fun'.

Any tips for our newbies?

If you give her 100% **attention**, you'll get 100% **focus** from your dog. So ... always have a plan and set up the teaching/training area or opportunity fully before you bring your dog in. You will then be able to give and hold attention for the entire session.

Keep it simple and fun for your dog to grow in confidence and tail waggin' attitude. **Build <u>every</u>** behaviour by laying a strong foundation and raising criteria in 'nth' degrees! **Play...a lot**.
